 - b. Like His crowning _____.
who redeems your life from the pit
and *crowns you with love and compassion*, (Psalm 103:4)
 - c. Like His consistent _____.
who *satisfies your desires with good things*
so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. (Psalm 103:5)

 - a. By remembering how He gave His _____.
