b. John was _____ about Jesus' identity.

When John, who was in prison, heard about the deeds of the Messiah,
he sent his disciples (2) to ask Him, “**Are You the One who is to come,**
or *should we expect someone else?*” (3)

* “... after me comes One who is more powerful ... His winnowing fork
is in His hand, and He will clear His threshing floor, gathering His wheat
into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable fire.” (Matt 3:11-12)
