Now Joseph had been taken down to Egypt. Potiphar, an Egyptian who was one of Pharaoh's officials, the captain of the guard, bought him from the Ishmaelites who had taken him there. (1)

b. When we choose to serve

The LORD was with Joseph *so that he prospered* ... When his master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD gave him success in everything he did, Joseph found favor in his eyes and became his attendant. Potiphar put him in charge ... and he entrusted to his care everything he owned ... the LORD blessed the household ... because of Joseph. (2-6c)
