2. Because people do not _____.

a. When you reject the Messiah, you miss the _____.

“Woe to you! Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. (21) But I tell you, *it will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon on the day of judgment* than for you.” (22)

* “From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked.” (Luke 12:48b-e)

b. When you reject the Messiah, you miss the _____.

“And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted to the heavens? No, *you will go down to Hades*. For if the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Sodom, it would have remained to this day. (23) But I tell you that it will be more bearable for Sodom **on the day of judgment** than for you.” (24)

* “Then He will say ... ‘Depart from Me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels ... Then they will go away to eternal punishment.’” (Matthew 25:41 and 46a)
