“So when you see standing in the holy place ‘*the abomination that causes desolation*,’ spoken of through the prophet Daniel -” (15a-b; Dan 9)

“**let the reader understand** ... *there will be great distress*, unequalled from the beginning of the world ... never to be equaled again.” (15c-21)

2. Understand the period of _____.

a. The _____.

“If those days had not been cut short, *no one would survive*, but for the sake of the elect those days will be shortened.” (22)

b. The _____.

“At that time if anyone says to you, ‘Look, here is the Messiah!’ ... do not believe it ... false ... prophets ... will perform great signs and wonders *to deceive* ... See, I have told you ahead of time ...” (23-28)

3. Understand the promise of _____.

a. The signs and the _____.

“Immediately after the distress of those days ‘the sun will be darkened ... the stars will fall from the sky ... *Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man* in heaven ... then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming ... with power and great glory. And He will send His angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather His elect ... from one end of the heavens to the other.” (29-31)

“Now learn this lesson ... when you see all these things, you know that it is near ... Truly I tell you, this generation [Israel] will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. Heaven and earth will pass away, but *My words will never pass away*.” (32-35)
