a. We intentionally engage like a dedicated _____.

Join with me in suffering, like a good soldier of Christ Jesus.

No one serving as a soldier gets entangled in civilian affairs, but rather *tries to please his commanding officer*. (3-4)

b. We intentionally engage like a disciplined _____.

Similarly, anyone who competes as an athlete does not receive the victor's crown except *by competing according to the rules*. (5)

c. We intentionally engage like a diligent _____.

The hardworking farmer should be *the first to receive a share* of the crops. Reflect on what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all this. (6-7)

3. To be strong in the grace ... we faithfully _____.

a. We faithfully endure by remembering the _____.

Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David.

This is my gospel, for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained. Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. (8-10)

Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with Him, we will also live with Him; if we endure, we will also reign with Him. If we disown Him, He will also disown us; if we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot disown Himself. (11-13)
