What does our Lord want us to do "until that day"?	
1. Until that day, for His direction.	
a. Ask and	
On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Where do You want us to make preparations for You to eat the Passover?" (17)	
He replied, "Go into the city to a certain man and tell him, 'The Teache says: My appointed time is near. I am going to celebrate the Passover with My disciples at your house.' " (18)	
b. Act and	<u>.</u> .
So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them and prepared the Passover. (19)	
* But when you ask, <u>you must believe</u> and not doubt (James 1:5-8)	
2. Until that day, every form of betrayal	
a. Sadness is a healthy	<u>.</u> •
When evening came, Jesus was at the table with the twelve. And He said, " one of you will betray Me." <i>They were very sad</i> and began to say to Him "Surely You don't mean me, Lord?" (20-22)	
b. Scripture is highly	
Jesus replied, " The Son of Man will go just as it is written about Hin But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born." (23-25; see Psalm 41:9 and John 6:64)	
* I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin (Psalm 119:11)	
3. Until that day, the coming kingdom.	
a. Remembering Him and our	•
While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it saying, "Take and eat; this is My body." (26)	
Then He took a cup saying, " This is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins." (27-28)	
b. Celebrating Him and our	÷
" I will not drink from the fruit of the vine from now on <b>until that day</b> when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom." When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. (29-30; Psalm 114-118	))

you proclaim the Lord's death <u>until</u> He	(1 Corinthians 11:26)
