What does our Lord want us to do "until that day"?

1. Until that day, _____ for His direction.

a. Ask and _____.

On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread,
*the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Where do You want us
to make preparations for You to eat the Passover?"* (17)

*He replied, "Go into the city to a certain man and tell him, 'The Teacher
says: My appointed time is near. I am going to celebrate the Passover
with My disciples at your house.'*" (18)

b. Act and _____.

*So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them
and prepared the Passover.* (19)

* ... But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt ... (James 1:5-8)

2. Until that day, _____ every form of betrayal.

a. Sadness is a healthy _____.

When evening came, Jesus was ... at the table with the twelve. And ...
He said, "... one of you will betray Me." *They were very sad* and began
to say to Him ... "Surely You don't mean me, Lord?" (20-22)

b. Scripture is highly _____.

Jesus replied, "... The Son of Man will go *just as it is written about Him*.
But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for
him if he had not been born." ... (23-25; see Psalm 41:9 and John 6:64)

* I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin ... (Psalm 119:11)

3. Until that day, _____ the coming kingdom.

a. Remembering Him and our _____.

While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when He had given
thanks, He broke it ... saying, "Take and eat; this is My body." (26)
Then He took a cup ... saying, "... This is My blood of the covenant,
which is poured out for many *for the forgiveness of sins*." (27-28)

b. Celebrating Him and our _____.

"... I will not drink from the fruit of the vine from now on **until that day**
when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom." When they had
sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. (29-30; Psalm 114-118)

For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup,
you proclaim the Lord's death until He _____. (1 Corinthians 11:26)
