a study of the third letter from John / 13-15

\_\_\_\_\_ to you. (15a)  
How can we continue to enjoy our Lord's peace and complete joy?  
We can continue to enjoy our Lord's peace and joy if we will ...

1. Keep looking in His \_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. Being careful to \_\_\_\_\_ His written Word.  
I have much to write to you, (13a)  
... the Word of God is *alive and active*. (Hebrews 4:12a; see 2 Timothy 3:16-17)
  - b. Being careful to \_\_\_\_\_ to His "spoken" Word.  
but I do not want to do so with pen and ink. (13b)  
"... the Advocate, the Holy Spirit ... will *teach you* all things  
and will *remind you* of everything I have said to you." (John 14:26)
  
2. Keep living by His \_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. By trusting His \_\_\_\_\_.  
I hope to see you soon, (14a)  
"Yes, I am coming *soon*." (Revelation 22:20b-c)
  - b. By preparing to meet Him in \_\_\_\_\_.  
and we will talk face to face. (14b)  
... when Christ appears ... All who have this hope in Him  
*purify themselves*, just as He is pure. (1 John 3:3)
  
3. Keep loving on His \_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. Remembering those who are with \_\_\_\_\_.  
**Peace to you.**  
*The friends here* send their greetings. (15a-b)  
... away from the body and *at home with the Lord*. (2 Corinthians 5:8)
  - b. Showing appreciation for those who are with \_\_\_\_\_.  
Greet *the friends there* by name. (15c)  
A friend loves *at all times*, (Proverbs 17:17a)

And the peace [and joy] of God ...

\_\_\_\_\_ all understanding ... (Philippians 4:7)
